Travelling by Rail

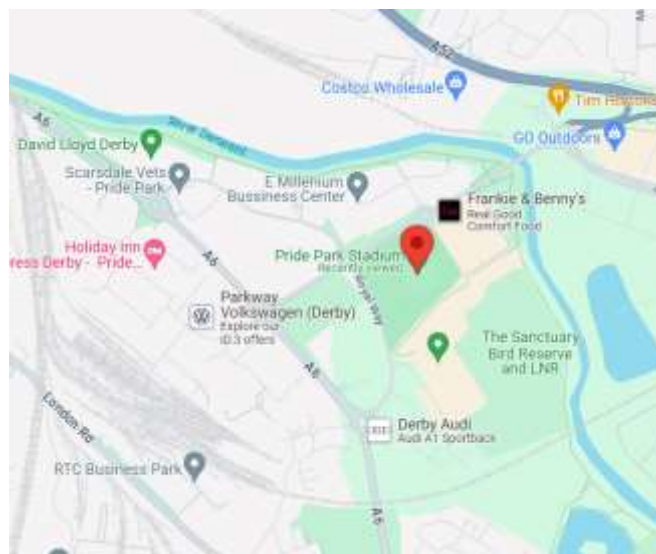
You can walk to Pride Park from Derby Railway Station; the route is signposted. A new exit has been opened at the station which leads directly onto the retail park. When you go up the stairs from the platform, turn right and walk to the end of the bridge. Go down the stairs, exit and turn right down Roundhouse Road. Bear left at the roundabout, go straight down Riverside Road or turn right go down Pride Parkway (where there are couple of places to eat and drink). The stadium is a about a 20-minute walk in total from the station using this route.
