We want to bring together forward-thinking 'thought leaders' from across ADEPT to examine the key issues and opportunities affecting our sector.

Together, we will create a forum to:

- Shape the way ADEPT members do business
- Create an environment for change
- Catalyse fresh thinking
- Influence strategy across place

Launching in Autumn 2019, there will be four one day sessions over a 12 month period, hosted by an independent facilitator:

- 20 September 2019
- 17 January 2020
- 20 March 2020

We want to create an enduring, self-sustaining and inclusive professional network of thought leaders and influencers, so we are looking for a diverse and inspiring group of 10-12 people who can, and will, make a difference.

Typically each session will include keynote speakers, structured discussions and activities to create thought pieces, policy proposals, blogs and articles that can be shared with a wide range of audiences to challenge and stimulate conversation. Topics will sit under one or more of ADEPT's strategic priorities:

- Place based funding post-Brexit
- · Communities and infrastructure
- Climate change and environment

Initial proposals, which may change as the group establishes and matures and as the political and policy landscape changes, include:

- Inward investment and green finance
- Innovation in procurement, linked to the developing Highways Sector Deal
- Designing customer-centric services
- Unchaining social value
- Delivering infrastructure and connectivity fit for the 21st century

- Participants need to commit to the full 12 month programme
- Participation is free (but does not include travel or subsistence costs)
- Focused on director level officers, we will also consider emerging 'place' leaders, as part of a pathway leadership development programme or thought leaders in their field. We will also consider thought leaders who are not necessarily working at director level within their organisation.
