The Board were delighted to receive presentations from the Midlands Engine Partnership and Cabinet Office.

- Rachael Greenwood (Executive Director) spoke to a presentation on what's happened at the Midlands Engine over the past year and what's going to happen this year, which led to a discussion on areas for collaborations.
